The Reading PLACE - More than 20,000 reading materials including magazines, newspapers, large-print books, fiction and nonfiction for children, teens, and adults.

The Meeting PLACE - Safe space for children of all ages to meet, discuss, and learn. Meeting space for small groups or tutors. Community programs including monthly book club, poetry contest, short story contest, author events.

The Learning PLACE - Research and homework with new online tools such as Gale Courses and Power Library.

The Work PLACE - Job, career, and small business programs and services. Resume building. Career Link training site.

The Tech PLACE - Free WiFi, public computers. Printing, faxing, scanning, online Dial-a-Story, Libby eBooks, and Kindles to borrow.

The Movie PLACE - Access to thousands of DVDs including movies and TV series, special screenings of documentaries and movies.

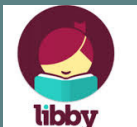
